



Use your Swedish passport as a stamp card at Burger King®

At the moment, one of the most powerful passports won't even take you to neighbouring Denmark.

The 2019 edition of the <u>Henley Passport Index</u> ranked Sweden's passport as the second best in the world as it provides visa-free or visa-on-arrival access to 187 countries, more than that of international heavyweights like the UK, US, and China. But that was beftore COVID-19.

The Swedish response to COVID-19 has repeatedly suffered criticism for being too relaxed, and many countries that have re-opened for travel don't welcome travelers from Sweden in particular.

The campaign is made by Burger King®'s Scandinavian agency INGO Stockholm.

HOW IT WORKS:

- » Bring a passport to your closest Burger King®. Only Swedish passports are accepted.
- » It now works as a stamp card, each stamp in your passport will give you a burger from the World Gourmet-series.
- » Max 5 stamps per passport. And you can only collect one burger per day.
