On May 23, Trump released his budget, which doubles down on massive budget cuts that would starve small towns and rural communities of jobs and opportunity. The proposed cuts would have a disproportionate impact on small towns across our country and leave those communities in crisis.

Hurts Rural Jobs and Businesses

- Eliminates rural business programs that have supported 800,000 jobs in the last 8 years.
- Ends rural energy programs that have helped 15,000 small businesses save on energy costs.
- Slashes support for bio-manufacturing that contributes \$393 billion to the U.S. economy.
- Lays off 5,200 USDA staff serving farmers and rural communities.

Hurts Small Towns and Rural Communities

- Zeros out support for clean water and safe sewers in small towns.
- Cuts rural air service by 50%, isolating remote communities.
- Jeopardizes investments in rural telemedicine and broadband.

Hurts Rural Families, Children, and Seniors

- Cuts SNAP support by 25%, leaving families hungry.
- Defunds rural health and safety research that combats the opioid epidemic.
- Eliminates rural housing programs that provide a path to home ownership.
